Case report

A 67-year-old male patient with a history of liver cirrhosis for years and hepatocellular carcinoma rupture post transarterial embolization three months ago

He presented to our hospital because of hematochezia and intermittent vomiting for one day. A computed tomography scan revealed status of HCC rupture post TAE, and some thrombus in SMV. He received colonoscopy, which revealed a transverse-colon tumor, so he received multiple random biopsies for the further diagnosis of tumor. The histopathological examination and the immunohistochemical study of colon tumor revealed hepatocellular carcinoma.

Discussion

In our case, presence of tumor thrombus in SMV connection could be correlated with hematogenous spreading of malignancy to the transverse colon. This will be the rare case report about hematogenous transverse colon metastasis from primary hepatocellular carcinoma.

Conclusion

Colonic metastasis should be considered in HCC patients presenting with abdominal pain and hematochezia.
